By The American Legion, Department of Michigan, in annual Department Convention assembled in Grand Rapids, Michigan, June 19-22, 2008, That members of the U.S. Congress be strongly urged to aggressively support legislation that adequately funds the health care needs of our returning veterans, including the hiring of PTSD counselors to work with returning OEF/OIF veterans, and the hiring of claims adjudicators to help reduce the unacceptable claims backlogs.
