SUBJECT: Asking for Michigan State Senate to pass House Joint Resolution M and N

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, House Joint Resolution M requires each public community and junior college to consider active duty and honorable discharged veterans of the armed forces as residents of that college's district for determining their tuition rates; and

WHEREAS, House Joint Resolution N requires public universities to consider certain veterans of the armed forces residents of this state for determining their tuition rates; and

WHEREAS, If these resolutions are not passed out of the Senate Appropriations committee at the August 2014 meeting; and

WHEREAS, If the full Senate does not vote on these resolutions in August, they will not make the November 2014 ballot; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion, Department of Michigan, in Department Executive Committee meeting, assembled in Lansing, Michigan, Saturday July 19th, 2014, That The American Legion, Department of Michigan, is asking that the Senate Appropriations committee ~~to~~ take action at the August 2014 meeting on House Joint Resolutions M and N; and be it finally

RESOLVED, That The American Legion Department of Michigan is asking the full Senate to vote to pass these resolutions at the August 2014 session to allow the people of Michigan to decide if these changes to the states constitution should be made.
