SUBJECT: National Leadership College Selection Process

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The American Legion holds a one week course, known as National American Legion College, each year in Indianapolis, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion, Department of Michigan, is encouraged to provide two candidates to be selected to attend; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Michigan has no formal promotion or selection process to recommend to the State Commander candidates to attend; and

WHEREAS, The State Commander has final say in the selection process; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion, Department of Michigan, in annual Department Winter Meeting assembled in Flint, Michigan, February 15-16, 2014, That The American Legion, Department of Michigan, create a Selection Board, made up of former NALC graduates; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Selection Board create Rules of Procedure for selection criteria; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Selection Board will meet at the Annual Department Convention for the purpose of making recommendations to the State Commander; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That the State Commander has the final decision in which Legionnaire attends the National American Legion College session.
