SUBJECT: Eagle Scout of the Year Award

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The American Legion, Department of Michigan Scouting Subcommittee wishes to increase interest, as well as the number of applicants, in the Eagle Scout of the Year Award; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion, Department of Michigan receives between two and six applicants each year for the award; and

WHEREAS, The recipient of The American Legion, Department of Michigan Eagle Scout Award currently receives a plaque and a certificate; and

WHEREAS, It takes an applicant for the Eagle Scout of the Year a great deal of time and effort in preparation to be an applicant for the Department award; and

WHEREAS, For the thirty-nine years that the National Eagle Scout of the Year award has been presented, not one of the 111 awards has gone to a Department of Michigan candidate; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion, Department of Michigan, in annual Department Convention, assembled in Kalamazoo, Michigan, June 29 - July 1, 2012, That The American Legion, Department of Michigan Eagle Scout recipient be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship, in addition to a certificate and plaque; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the \$1,000 scholarship be presented annually at the Department Convention; and be it

FINALLY RESOLVED, That the Eagle Scout recipient also receive reimbursement of all travel expenses to attend the Department Convention.
