SUBJECT: Establish a Michigan World War One Centennial Commission

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Congress of the United States of America has established, with HR 6364, 112th Congress (2011-2012), a National World War I Centennial Commission; and

WHEREAS, Section 5, Duties of Centennial Commission, Subsection (a)(2) reads, "To encourage private organizations and state and local governments to organize and participate in activities commemorating the centennial of World War I; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion, Department of Michigan, in annual Department Convention, assembled in Livonia, Michigan, June 27 - June 29, 2014, That The American Legion, Department of Michigan, urge the State of Michigan and the Governor to establish and appoint a Michigan World War I Centennial Commission to ensure a suitable observance of the Centennial of World War I and to provide for the designation of memorials to the service of members of the United States Armed Forces (especially those from Michigan) in World War I; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department Adjutant be authorized and instructed to forward a copy of this resolution, with proper cover letter, to each member of the Michigan Legislature and the Michigan's Governor.
