

Criteria for Blood Donor Awards

1. 10 to 19 gallons - A certificate signed by the Department Commander and the Blood, Eye & Vital Organ Chairman and sent to the recipient.
2. 20 to 29 gallons - A Plaque and Bronze Citizenship Medal. Plaque signed by the Department Commander and the Department Adjutant to be presented at a Legion function.
3. 30 to 39 gallons - A Plaque and Silver Citizenship Medal. Plaque signed by the Department Commander and the Department Adjutant and presented at a Legion function.
4. 40 gallons or more - A plaque and Gold Citizenship Medal. Plaque signed by the Department Commander and the Department Adjutant and presented at a Legion function.
5. A Legion function would be the Fall Conference, Winter Meeting or Department Convention. The recipient's registration at a Legion function should be paid for by the Department or Blood, Eye & Vital Organ Committee.
6. The Auxiliary and SAL will also be included in the above awards with each of them paying for any plaques and medals.
7. All recipients of a plaque, medal or certificate will have their name on the "American Legion Family Blood Donor Club" honor roll which will be placed on the Legion website and published in the Legionnaire.
8. For platelet donors 8 credits equals 1 gallon of whole blood.
9. Plaque & \$100.00 for the Post with the most individual blood donors as reported on their CPR.
