Larry Chase spoke about the POW/MIA remains of 2nd Lt. Robert W. Ward of the Army Air Force were recovered.


Blood, Eye and Vital Organ Subcommittee Chairman Spolarich mentioned that he will be giving a class on how to give a blood drive.
