MINUTES: It was moved by Stan Kennedy and supported by Laverne Spolarich that the minutes of the National Security and Foreign Relations Committee be approved. Motion approved.

NEW BUSINESS: POW/MIA report by Stan Kennedy; collecting data and reviewing D.P.O. statistics on recovery, 50-60 identified. U.S. and Russia teamed up to help identify based on locations and incidents. Recommend each Post utilize POW/MIA empty chair and educate their members. Stan Kennedy urged all present to contact their elected leaders so that they do not forget.

Today is POW/MIA National Day of Remembrance . Ceremony is in Novi at 5 p.m. at Memorial Gardens by 12 Oaks Mall. Discussion ensued regarding the efforts around the state to educate students and the community. Members and guest shared their ideas. We should not let them be forgotten.

Blood and Vital Organ report by Laverne Spolarich; the DEC will be introduced to the Gift of Life rep., Jennifer Tislerics. Leading candidate Jim Koutz for National Commander endorsed the cause of our committee and solicited comments or concerns.

Chairman Austin spoke about our nation's immigration policy. Do we need a resolution issued addresses by Richard Dubay. We have resolutions already in motion. Confusing and competing resolutions, bills, and other positions exist in many states. Post SAL Department Commander Svacha urged all present to take material from his display in the hotel and take back to your Post.
