

SERVICE OFFICER AWARDS

Carlton L. Seaman = For Best Post Service Officer

Albert R. Thiel, Sr. = For Best District Service Officer

Leo M. Leggett = For Best County Counselor

Meritorious Citations = For meritorious service to war veterans and The American Legion as Service Officers

March 1st – State Headquarters will mail a Service Officer report to each Service Officer around March 1st.

April 30th – Service Officers need to submit this report form to his/her respective District Service Officer no later than April 30th.

May 15th – District Service Officers will select one Post Service Officer per District and forward that report to the State VA & R Chairman.

June 1st – The State VA & R Chairman will determine the winner and notify the State Adjutant. Primary consideration will be given to advice, counseling, and service actually rendered by the Post Service Officer and consideration given to Post size, community served and the opportunity for serving veterans.

The Leggett Award will be determined by the Director of Veterans Affairs and presented at the Annual Veterans Service Officer School.

The award recipients will be announced and awards presented at the Annual Department Fall Conference. In the event recipients cannot be in attendance at Fall Conference, the VA & R Chairman will make arrangements to present the award in their local area.
