8-11-C same as 7-11-C to establish a State Veterans Cemetery in the U.P. of Michigan. Recommend approval by unanimous vote.

Chairman reviewed highlights of Director Topps report to the Standing Committee and the new employees. He also reported on the current procedure in process for awarding State funding to the VA&R coalition members.

There was discussion regarding the suicide hot lines for OIF/OEF Veterans and if any information is available regarding numbers related to previous wars.


We also discussed the Vet Clinics and the services & counseling available through them.
