CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Permanent Time and Place Committee was called to order by James Wallace, Chairman at 2:35 p.m.

ROLL CALL

The following members were present: Chairman James Wallace, Secretary Steve Striggow, Mike Buda, Larry Money and Brett Holt.

GUESTS

There were 13 guests present.

There was a Quorum.

Minutes of the June Convention Committee meeting were read. Motion by Holt, seconded by Buda, to accept the minutes. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Jerry Dennis gave a report on the 2020 Convention in Kalamazoo. Room rates per night will be \$115 for single or double, \$125 for 3 or 4 in a room and \$155 for a suite, plus an additional \$10 for more than 2 in a suite. At present there will be a four dollar per day parking charge, but the committee is working with the hotel to get that removed.

Ray Carlson reported on the 2021 Convention at the Kewadin Casino in Sault Ste. Marie. Room rates will be \$85 for single and double, \$95 for 3 or 4 and \$105 for suites and parking is free.

Inspection is needed at Shanty Creek for Fall 2021. A date of October 17 to go up and do the inspection.

NEW BUSINESS

There are no bids to host winter and fall 2022.

Adjutant Runyan brought up the fact that if you need a hospitality room, please contact the chairman and **DO NOT** go through the hotel to avoid confusion. This needs to be done as soon as possible if you want to assure that you can get the type of room you need.

Jerry Dennis brought up that most hotels have few if any dedicated hospitality rooms. Perhaps we should look into doing them like the Four Corners Party at National. All hospitality in one large room, set up around the perimeter, with social area in the center.

There being no further business to come before the committee, a motion was made by Money and seconded by Holt to adjourn. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 3:02 p.m.
