If we start with post sponsoring little league baseball ages 12 years to 14 years age group that will be your Junior League and you keep them interested with baseball once they get into high school. That will be your Senior teams because you have the teams and coaching staff. Kim talked about her plans to improve baseball in her District/Zone with the post sponsoring parks and recreation teams. We need to show what value American Legion Baseball has to offer over Travel Teams. Promote how many of our American Legion players have been recruited to play college baseball with scholarships and to the Major Leagues.

Nelson – Regionals for AA will be in Kentucky this year.

Jeff – spoke to SAL Dept to donate \$500 for each Zone for zone tournaments. For Chief Umpire for AA is Dale Clyde and Chief Umpire for A is Brian York.
