Special Notice From National:

National sent out a mailing promoting the PUFL program to approximately 370, 000 individuals of which 75,000 were SAL members. National states that is was an error in the criteria used to extract addresses for the mailing, not another issue with the new system. They have corrected the issue so it shouldn't happen again. Please inform your SAL members that there is still no PUFL program for them at this time and that the mailing was supposed to be for Legion members only.

Helpful Information from the Department Membership Secretary

- Processing membership for the 2020, 2021 and 2022 years are still available.
- Just a reminder, the 65% membership target date for Posts is Nov. 10, 2021.
- Be on the lookout for some of your member's ID numbers to have changed for both the Posts and the Squadrons. Any members who have a membership ID number starting with 100 or 200 may have a new membership ID number starting with 350, 351 or 352.
- Just to reiterate: National sent PUFL information to both Post and Squadron members by mistake. There still is no PUFL program for the Squadrons. Still only a Legion Program.

Mission Blue Grant - Post Assistance Program Update

Could your Post use an additional \$1000 to \$2000? The Mission Blue post assistance program is here to help your post with a financial need. Posts that have qualified in the past can submit another application for an additional \$1000 as well!

For Posts that have never filed an application, you can request up to \$2000 now. The National organization has authorized new limits with different guidelines. Mission Blue <u>UPDATE</u> - if a post has already received a grant, they can reapply for an additional \$1,000. Only need an application. No other documents required.

Posts who have not submitted and meet all of the qualifications on the application, they can receive up to \$2,000.

If a post has met all of the qualifications on the application, except for the insurance requirement and/or the CPR requirement, the post can receive up to \$1,000.

Scholarships for High School Students Are Available:

Oratorical Contest Scholarships-

The American Legion Oratorical Contest contestants compete at the department level for \$2,000 for first place, \$1,500 for second place, and \$1,000 for third place with scholarships. The first-place winner will advance to the national contest for an **opportunity to win \$20,000**, \$22,500, or \$25,000 in scholarship money. Registrations are due November 12th and must be completed online at www.michiganlegion.org/oratorical.

William D. & Jewell Brewer Scholarship - \$500 Award

Available to only Michigan residents who are <u>high school seniors or college students</u> – without a bachelor's degree, who are a son, daughter, grandchild or great-grandchild of a war-time veteran planning to or are attending any nationally accredited college or university or trade school. Selection is based on a student's G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher, financial need, parent's or grandparent's honorable active war-time military service, goals, and intentions. Scholarships are \$500 and non-renewable. <u>Application due January 3, 2022</u>.

Guy M. Wilson Scholarship - \$500 Award

Available to only Michigan residents who are <u>high school seniors</u> and are a son, daughter, grandchild or great-grandchild of a war-time veteran planning to or are attending any Michigan accredited college or university or trade school. Selection is based on a student's G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher, financial need, parent's or grandparent's honorable active war-time military service, goals, and intentions. Scholarships are \$500 and non-renewable. <u>Application due January 3, 2022</u>.
