What It Means To Sponsor A Boy For Boys State

This year's session of Michigan Boys State is just around the corner and we could not be more excited about what this year's program holds for the young men who will be attending. Those who participate will learn firsthand about leadership, practical citizenship, and the democratic process. It is an excellent academic opportunity and experience.

In order for our program to flourish we need the support of our American Legion Posts. We encourage each Post to work with their local schools, civic organizations, and youth clubs to nominate delegates for the program.

Each participant, or "delegate," who is selected to attend Michigan Boys State is sponsored by an organization or individual. Sponsors define the selection process and provide the financial support for the citizen to attend the week long session covering food, lodging and all other aspects of the program. Once at Grand Valley State University, a citizen's week is completely covered by the sponsorship. This removes the financial burden from the family of the young men selected and is one of many ways Michigan Boys State works to provide equal opportunities to attendees of the program.

This year Boys State will be **held June 12-18**, on the campus of Grand Valley State University in Allendale, Michigan. The **cost to sponsor a delegate is \$400**. There is also a delegate application fee of \$25 which the delegate is to pay. For the 2022 session we have <u>opened the program to both high school juniors and seniors</u>.

There are many ways your Post can raise money to help sponsor a delegate. Some Posts will host community fundraisers (i.e. fish fry, meatloaf or spaghetti dinner) or they will contact local businesses to solicit donations to cover the cost of registration. Posts can even split the cost of a sponsorship if they are not able to fund the entire amount.

As you promote Boys State in your community and recruit boys finishing 11th grade and current seniors to participate in this week that shapes a lifetime, please remember that all of your efforts count. Finding young men to participate, sponsoring them at the Post level, and finding community sponsors are all ways that you can help. American Legion members and Posts can do all or part of what it takes to fill our Michigan Boys State roster.

The application deadline has been extended to May 23rd.

There is still time to recruit students for this program. Contact your local school principal, counselor, or social studies teacher to have them help you identify a potential delegate.

As always, if you have more delegates than the post can afford please send their application in to department headquarters so that the Boys State Committee can work on matching those delegates up with other sponsors.

If your post has the funds for a delegate(s) but no local student interested, here are some options:

Mail your \$400 sponsorship check in to department and **indicate** one of the following:

- 1. Use the sponsorship for a delegate(s) who reside anywhere in Michigan.
- 2. Use the sponsorship for a delegate(s) within your American Legion district.
- 3. Use the sponsorship for a delegate(s) within your American Legion zone.

American Legion Boys State

What: The American Legion Boys State program is a non-partisan, non-political mock government exercise in a model state designed to mirror the structure and operation of its respective state government. It is intended to instill character, the importance of civic engagement and patriotism among rising high school seniors.

When: June 12-18, 2022

Where: Grand Valley State University- Allendale, MI

Eligibility: Male high school juniors going into their senior year in the fall of 2022. Also open to Senior for the 2022 session.

Application Deadline: May 23, 2022 Cost: \$25 Delegate Application Fee

\$400 Sponsor Fee

Sponsor: A sponsor can be an American Legion Post, Son of the American Legion Squadron, an American Legion Auxiliary Unit, but it can also be the boy's parents, a business owner, a school, or other organization like the Elks, Knights of Columbus, or a Moose club.

Scholarships:

Samsung Scholarship: limited to students between their junior and senior years of high school who attend the current session of either an American Legion Boys State or American Legion Auxiliary Girls State program and are a direct descendant of a wartime U.S. military veteran who served on active duty during at least one of the periods of war officially designated as eligibility dates for American Legion membership. Up to \$10,000 scholarship awarded.

What: The American Legion Auxiliary Girls State program is a non-partisan, non-political mock government exercise in a model state designed to mirror the structure and operation of its respective state government. It is intended to instill character, the importance of civic engagement and patriotism among rising high school seniors.

When: June 12-17, 2022

Where: Virtual

Eligibility— Female high school juniors going into their

senior year in the fall of 2022.

Sponsor Reservation Deadline: April 30, 2022

Online Delegate Registration Deadline: May 31, 2022

Cost: \$30 Delegate Registration Fee

\$175 Sponsor Fee

Sponsor: Girls State delegates' registration fees are paid for by the sponsoring local American Legion Auxiliary unit with additional support and funding sometimes coming from various civic and nonprofit organizations.

Scholarship:
