## **Mission Blue Grant - Post Assistance Program Update**

Could your Post use an additional \$1000 to \$2000? The Mission Blue post assistance program is here to help your post with a financial need. Posts that have qualified in the past can submit another application for an additional \$1000 as well!

For Posts that have never filed an application, you can request up to \$2000 now. The National organization has authorized new limits with different guidelines. Mission Blue <u>UPDATE</u> - if a post has already received a grant, they can reapply for an additional \$1,000. Only need an application. No other documents required.

Posts who have not submitted and meet all of the qualifications on the application, they can receive up to \$2,000.

If a post has met all of the qualifications on the application, except for the insurance requirement and/or the CPR requirement, the post can receive up to \$1,000.

## **Scholarships for High School Students Are Available:**

## William D. & Jewell Brewer Scholarship - \$500 Award: Application due January 3, 2022.

Available to only Michigan residents who are <u>high school seniors or college students</u> – without a bachelor's degree, who are a son, daughter, grandchild or great-grandchild of a war-time veteran planning to or are attending any nationally accredited college or university or trade school. Selection is based on a student's G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher, financial need, parent's or grandparent's honorable active war-time military service, goals, and intentions. Scholarships are \$500 and non-renewable.

## Guy M. Wilson Scholarship - \$500 Award: Application due January 3, 2022.

Available to only Michigan residents who are <u>high school seniors</u> and are a son, daughter, grand-child or great-grandchild of a war-time veteran planning to or are attending any Michigan accredited college or university or trade school. Selection is based on a student's G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher, financial need, parent's or grandparent's honorable active war-time military service, goals, and intentions. Scholarships are \$500 and non-renewable.

# Eagle Scout of the Year-\$1,000 Award: Applications due March 1st, 2022

Boy scouts who are members of an American Legion, Department of Michigan post troop and have obtained the level of eagle scout or are the descendant of American Legion members may apply. The winner at the department level receives a \$1,000 scholarship and is advanced to the national level for consideration for Eagle Scout of the Year and a \$10,000 scholarship. 
