Deadline Extension for CPR'S: Has Your Post Turn One In?

The Consolidated Post Report (CPR) was established in 1975 in order to assist departments in the documentation of the various activities a specific post has done during the twelve-month reporting period, June 1 through May 31. The CPR may be the most beneficial document the post will complete. The post's information, combined with that of other posts, is used when the National Commander and others testify on Capitol Hill as mandated by our federal charter. Each post has a story to tell and when we speak collectively our strength is magnified.

Deadline to submit your Consolidated Post Report has been extended to July 15.

If you haven't turned in a CPR now is the time to do it. The CPR can be filled out online in MyLegion or you can contact Deanna in Membership at 517-220-2756 or member@michiganlegion.org for assistance.
