Asbestos material was installed in many Michigan factories, used in products

and used in buildings; and

WHEREAS.

Michigan Veterans who returned from service found work in those factories,

working with those products and in those buildings; and

WHEREAS,

Asbestos was found to be a cause of cancer; and

WHEREAS.

There is no evidence that Asbestos cases filed in Michigan are fraudulent;

and

WHEREAS,

Wayne County Courts have created a fair and proper system for both the

plaintiffs and defendants to maintain the due process rights, and

WHEREAS,

40% of Asbestos cases filed in Michigan are filed by Veterans; and

WHEREAS,

Citizens who feel Asbestos products caused them harm have a right to file

legal suits against those responsible, and

WHEREAS.

Those legal suits should be allowed there due process in the courts; be it
