WHEREAS, The 124th Cavalry Regiment saw action in the Pacific Theater in such places as Burma and China; and

WHEREAS, Stanley K. Sloan served his country with honor and returned home to Michigan where he lived the rest of his life raising a family and continuing to serve he country in The American Legion, The VFW and The Disabled American Veterans; and

WHEREAS, Stanley K. Sloan transferred to Post Everlasting on April 7, 2020, and is now interred in the Silver Lake Cemetery located in Wolverine, Michigan; and

WHEREAS, The naming of this building is a small way for this man's great sacrifice to be remembered by his fellow veterans; and

WHEREAS, The American Legion is an organization dedicated to remembering our fallen comrades and honoring them in all appropriate ways; now, therefore, be it
