**SUBJECT: Establish an Annual Award for Service Members Who Perform

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The American Legion National Organization has a program which recognizes Active Duty Service Members who perform acts of community service; and

WHEREAS, This program increases the awareness to Service Members and to their base command of what The American Legion does; and

WHEREAS, It increases the awareness of the media and to the public, The American Legion Programs and Principles; and

WHEREAS, Currently, the Department of Michigan has no means of recognizing Active Duty service members; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion, Department of Michigan, in annual Fall Conference assembled in Muskegon, Michigan, September 23-25, 2022, establish an annual award for Service Members who perform community service to be presented at the Commander's Banquet at the Winter Meeting; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The Americanism Committee shall receive from each branch of service, the name of a Service Member who has performed service while serving in Michigan; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That each recipient will receive a plaque and, in addition, one (1) night hotel, plus \$100 per diem, to attend the Winter Meeting; and, be it

FINALLY RESOLVED, This action shall take place at the close of Fall Conference on September 25, 2022.
