**SUBJECT:** Consolidated Post Report (CPR) Requirements from Posts to Receive Membership Cards

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS,** The Consolidated Post Report (CPR) was established in 1975 in order to assist Departments in the documentation of the various activities a specific post has done during the twelve (12) month reporting period, June 1 through May 31; and

**WHEREAS,** The Post's information, combined with that of other Posts, is used when the National Commander, and others, testify on Capitol Hill as mandated by our Federal charter; and

**WHEREAS,** Each Post has a story to tell and, when we speak collectively, our strength is magnified; and

**WHEREAS,** The American Legion urges all Posts to submit a CPR annually; and

**WHEREAS,** The Department of Michigan continues to receive only approximately two-thirds (2/3) of Post's CPR's annually; and

**WHEREAS,** Posts have two (2) options of entering and submitting the CPR; either a hard copy or through MyLegion.org; and

**WHEREAS,** There is a current requirement for Posts within the Department to receive their Post membership cards; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** By The American Legion, Department of Michigan, in annual Department Convention assembled in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, July 12-14, 2024, that the Department is to add a new requirement for all Posts to submit their Post CPR to receive their membership cards, starting in 2025; and, be it

**FINALLY RESOLVED,** That the Department Adjutant is directed to modify the requirements to add this change for all Post membership cards.
